FLIES.



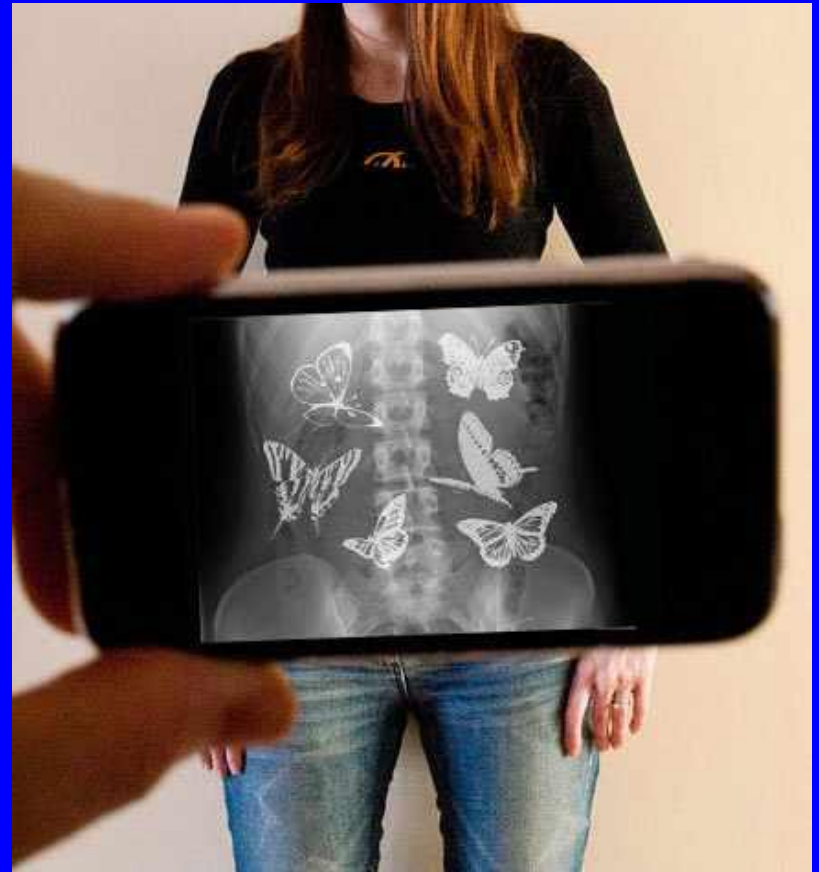
TIME GOES SO FAST.
